Mathematics Center In-Person Tutoring Hours

Location: Cook Library (LIB) 139, 1st Floor

Walk-in Service - No Appointment Necessary! Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday: 11 AM – 5 PM

Tuesday: 1 PM - 7 PM

Closed on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

The Mathematics Center will open Monday, January 22nd and will close for the semester on Thursday, May 2nd.

Students can drop-in for assistance in the Mathematics Center for any math class up through MAT 340. Tutors will be available to assist to clarify understanding of concepts, give guidance in test preparation, and work through common sources of conceptual misunderstandings. Tutors are not allowed to complete any academic work for any student. Tutors will rotate among all students needing assistance in the Mathematics Center.

The Mathematics Center has workspaces for students to work independently and also has four small-group study rooms. Tutors will be rotating among students to help within the Center if any student or group has a question. Each study room has markers, a whiteboard, a table, and 4 chairs.

Mathematics Center Online Tutoring

The Mathematics Center will open Monday, January 22nd and will close for the semester on Thursday, May 2nd.

Students have access to free individualized assistance for most MAT courses ranging from MAT 100 through MAT 340. Any appointment booked through the website will be ONLINE only. Students should make an appointment at least two hours in advance and should cancel at least an hour in advance of their appointment if they are unable to attend. Failure to cancel or signing on more than 10 minutes late will result in the appointment being classified as a "no show." Two or more no-shows for a student during one semester will result in deactivation of the WCOnline account and a required meeting with the Mathematics Center Director before services will be reinstated. Students should email emileigh.mccardle@usm.edu to arrange a meeting if their account has been deactivated due to appointment no-shows.

Mathematics tutoring appointments are 45 minutes long, and students can book one appointment per week. The appointments will be held through Microsoft Teams. Tutors assist to clarify understanding of concepts, give guidance in test preparation, and work through common sources of conceptual misunderstandings. Tutors are not allowed to complete any academic work for any student.

Students wanting to meet in-person with a tutor should come in-person to the Mathematics Center on the Hattiesburg Campus in the Cook Library, Room 139. No appointment is necessary for in-person services, and the HBG Mathematics Center is open Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 11 AM – 5 PM and Tuesday from 1 PM – 7 PM. Students would NOT use the website to book an appointment if using this option.
